By providing a forum to see artists, authors, musicians, filmmakers and other interesting speakers, we strive to make our small town library a welcoming place where the community can gather, attend a lecture, view a film, discuss books and meet people in town who share similar interests.

The Friends have instituted and sponsor the following programs:

The New Yorker Roundtable- read & discuss current articles in the magazine, led by Diana Loevy.

Two Adult Book Discussion Groups - meeting monthly in the library with a professional moderator, Wednesday evening - led by Dr. Lisa Dresdner, Professor of English, Norwalk Community College and Thursday morning – led by Diana Loevy, author of The Book Club Companion. The library provides copies of the selected books.

Lunch & Learn – a lunchtime program. Bring your brown bag lunch and listen to a lecture. Past topics have included: local authors, using your smart phone, how to use digital media, gardening tips and taking better photographs.

Films – Presenting current popular movies and documentaries, often with writers/directors in attendance to answer questions about the screening.

Pajama Pictures – A children’s film series offered during the summer.

Play with Your Food – A special Weston performance of the well-known theater program that includes lunch, short plays and a post-performance talk back.

Animal Embassy –Exciting nature programs for both children and adults.
