11AM-4PM General Public; Families By Appointment Only

The Library will be open for browsing and borrowing materials beginning August 10 following the schedule above. 15 patrons at a time will be permitted in the Library to browse the collections and select materials. Masks must be worn at all times. Browsing the Children's Room is by appointment only. Families and individuals may reserve a 15 minute time slot for browsing in the Children's Room. Self-Service Holds

While the Library will discontinue Curbside Pick Up, patrons may still request books and have them checked out and ready for pick up in the Library café. Please wait for an email or text notification that your holds are available before coming to the Library to pick them up. Holds will be available for 5 days.

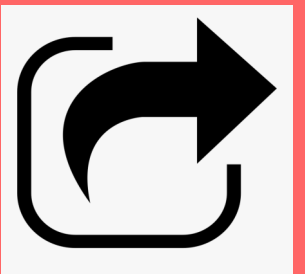

The Library's exterior book drop will be available for returning materials. No items may be returned inside the building. All returns will be quarantined for 96 hours. No late fees will accrue during this time.

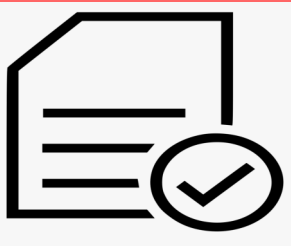
Accessing The Library

Enter through the sliding glass doors at the Community Room Entrance. Please return all items in the exterior book drop before entering the building. No returns will be accepted inside the Library. Please use the available hand sanitizer when entering the building. *Please note that at this time:*

- *There are no public restrooms available*
- *No room reservations or gatherings are permitted*

Masks must be worn at all times for ages 2+, per CDC guidelines. The Library will be unable to provide you with a mask if you come without one. If you are unable to wear a mask, please use Self Service Holds and call the Library to arrange a curbside delivery.

Exit through the front door of the Library. Hand sanitizer is also available at the exit.

Please wait for an email or text notification that your items are available for pick up before coming to the Library.

Patrons may request up to 5 adult items and 10 children's items per card, or up to 20 items total per family for Self-Service Holds. DVDs are capped at 5 per pickup. *All requests must be received at least 24 hours in advance of pickup time. Holds will be available for 5 days.*

Holds will be bagged and available for pick up during business hours (10-11AM for Seniors, 11AM-4PM General Public Monday-Saturday) in the café area of the Library.
